Swiss National Holiday in SUTTON!

Sutton, July 12, 2010 - On Saturday, July 31st, the Swiss community and its many friends will celebrate the Swiss National Holiday for a 34th consecutive year at the Mont SUTTON Ski station who, in turn, is celebrating its 50th anniversary of skiing bliss this year. The Federation of Swiss Societies in Eastern Canada (FSSEC), the Town of Sutton, and the Corporation de développement économique de Sutton (CDES) are happy to bring together Sutton residents, merchants, and the Swiss population.

Sutton residents may purchase their entrance ticket at the Sutton Tourist Office at 24-A, Main Street South. For a second year running, a **Free Shuttle Service**, sponsored by the CDES, will operate between the village and the mountain from 12h30 (noon) until 01h00 am.

FSSEC Tombola tickets (1st prize: a pair of plane tickets, business class, to Switzerland) are on sale at the Tourist Office and in different businesses in Sutton.

Wines from Sutton's local vineyards, Chapelle Ste-Agnès and Domaine Bresee, will be sold on the premises Saturday.

New This Year!

In an effort to offer an authentic Swiss experience to the visitors, the traditional Swiss raclette has been added to the menu.

Also this year, the Federation of Swiss Societies in Eastern Canada wish to recognize the contribution of Swiss families who have been established in Sutton for many years. The Dettwiler, Francey, Kaempf, Lengacher, and Schweizer families, to name just a few, have participated, through the years, to the yearly Swiss festivities as well as to Sutton's tourist development.

Friday, July 30th, 2010 – The Town of Sutton will hold an open air market and sidewalk sale on its Main Street, from 3pm to 9pm, to the sound of Swiss and local musicians. People will sample local wines and a Swiss beer and watch artists at work. The Evelyn Lambart, Côté films, Côté jardin exhibition at the Sutton Museum will be open to visitors from noon to 4pm.
